

Bye laws for Contribution to the International Journal of Microgravity Application (IJMSA)

The International Journal of Microgravity Application (IJMSA) is published by the Japan Society of Microgravity Application (JASMA). The journal covers original articles and topics which are related to the advancement of research for microgravity application.

1. Scope and categories

1.1 Original Article

"Original Articles" deal with theory, methods, techniques and instrumentation in any field of science which promote the application of microgravity.

1.2 Review

"Review" papers pertain to up-to-date research topics including specific research by authors. The review should list up proper references.

2. Original Articles

2.1 Language

Manuscripts should be written in English or Japanese.

2.2 Number of page

No page limitation.

2.3 Authors should consider the duration for review process.

2.4 Regulations for double contribution

A manuscript sent to the International Journal of Microgravity Application (IJMSA) should not be simultaneously considered for publication by another journal.

A manuscript which has been published or has been submitted for publication to another journal should not be submitted to the International Journal of Microgravity Application (IJMSA) as original articles.

3. Submission of manuscript

3.1 Original article and Review

A manuscript should be written in accordance with the "Instruction to authors" specified elsewhere.

If the paper is written in Japanese, English translation for title, authors name, organization, and address should also be provided.

English abstract about 100 words and keywords should be attached to original article and review.

Captions for tables and figures should be written in English.

3.2 Cover Sheet

A cover sheet, specified in other document, should be filled out with all necessary information, including the category of the research paper and authors information, and be attached to the submitted manuscript.

3.3 Submission

The electronic files (manuscripts, cover sheet) should be sent to the editorial office specified in Chap 7. After the acceptance of the manuscripts, authors are requested to submit forms for copyright transfer and payment of publication fee/ reprint.

4. Procedures after submission (Reviewing)

4.1 Acceptance

When the manuscript is received, the receiving date will be notified to the author by the Editorial Committee.

4.2 Reviewing

1) The contributed papers are all subject to peer review by the Editorial Committee. Manuscripts of Original Articles will be reviewed by two reviewers, while Those of Review will be reviewed by one reviewer. Acceptance or rejection of the paper will be determined by the Editorial Committee, based on the comments from reviewer(s).

2) The Editorial Committee can ask the author to revise the manuscript.

3) If the revised manuscript is not sent to the Editorial Committee within 6 months, the manuscript will be categorized as withdrawn.

4) If the Editorial Committee accepts a paper for publication, the author will be notified.

4.3 Proof reading

The author is responsible for proof reading. The corrections should be restricted to typographical errors.

4.4 Publication charge and Reprint

The authors of articles should pay the publication charge or buy reprints (50 copies at minimum). If the article is written by a request from editorial committee, these payments are not mandatory. Publication fee and Reprint free are shown in the appendix.

5. Copyright

5.1 The copyright of papers published in the International Journal of Microgravity Application (IJMSA) belongs to the Japan Society of Microgravity Application (JASMA).

5.2 Upon transferring the copyright from the authors to JASMA, JASMA will permit the following right to the authors or authors' organizations;

- 1) All rights (such as patent) other than copyright which are related to the contributed paper.
- 2) The right to use a part or all contents of the contributed papers to other publications.
- 3) The right to make personal copies if the following conditions are satisfied;
 - (1) Origin should be specified as the International Journal of Microgravity Application (IJMSA)
 - (2) Copyright of JASMA should be specified.
 - (3) Not for commercial use. JASMA is not responsible for the copied papers.
- 4) The right to distribute part or all the content of the contributed paper to limited persons/organizations prior to the publication by JASMA.

6. Prohibition of misconduct and inadequate action

Regarding to submission, the authors should prohibit the misconduct and inadequate action established by the ethical code of JASMA.

7. Revision of this document

This document will be revised by the Editorial Committee with the authorization from the General Committee.
